(Boarding students from afar should arrive Monday afternoon, July 6 and leave Sunday morning, July 19. Anyone staying in the monastery must provide proof of health insurance. International students must purchase health/travel insurance, which is available through school.)

Room & Board for parents with children: \$250/adult, \$150/child under 12
